Exhibit Hall Badge Pickup: MGM Grand Conference Center Level 1 of the hotel, beginning at 9am on Sunday. Security will not allow you on the Show floor without a badge.

Shipments will be received at the exhibit facility ONLY on: Sunday, March 1, 2026 between 8:00 AM 8:00 PM. Any shipments received outside these listed times will incur additional charges.

Exhibit Structures: Exhibit structures should be made of fireproof/flame-retardant or treated materials not given to flammability. Expanded foam materials should be fire retardant. Structurally, any “built-up” (or double-decker) booth should have the stamp of a qualified structural engineer attesting to its construction standards. Building Permit from the Las Vegas Fire Department.

At no time are exhibitors allowed to bring helium balloons into the facility. Helium tanks cannot be brought into the facility. All air and gasses must be ordered through your Event Services Manager.
